Fake News From Social Media

Which news sources will you trust when fake news is all around us? With a quick push of a button, false rumors, inaccurate reporting, and conspiracy can spread quickly on social media. Unexpected or incorrect information can cause harm or manipulate people.

It's human nature to seek out information that reflects our beliefs or views of the world. This tendency is known as *confirmation bias*. If we are engaging in confirmation bias, we're likely to dismiss credible information that should be true stories. Thinking twice before putting something on the internet in the first place can reduce fake news.

People who are active on the internet or social media often share fake news unintentionally because they believe it. Considering supporting sources and reading beyond are the other ways to stop fake news. All in all, reducing fake news will only work if we all work together.
